Kit required to take part: a smartphone, compact camera or DSLR

The best camera you have is the one you have with you at the time. Today, in 2024, this often means the phone that you carry with you daily. Smartphones have very powerful camera functionality. During this course, whether you come with a big camera or a smartphone, we can empower you to get the very most out of your device via some engaging and inspiring creative challenges.

Topics to cover:

- Light. It's all about the light! Learning to see light is the most important skill for all kinds of photography. We will explore the importance of light, learn to identify and use the available light, explore easy and fun ways to supplement what's available in order to make interesting compositions.
- Scene-setting and storytelling. We'll explore how to communicate a message whether photographing portraits, landscapes or abstract images.
- Composition. We'll discuss how to compose your photos to make compelling pictures. These skills can dramatically improve your photography regardless of the equipment.
- The exposure triangle, i.e. the relationship between shutter speed, ISO (aka film speed) and aperture. Without killing any creativity (!) we will touch on a little science and some 'light' camera rules.
